Student Enrichment Events

Flyer Cart – All Year

The Flyer Cart was created to help recognize positive behavior for students in grades 1-6. Students earn Faithful Flyer cards when demonstrating joy, kindness, or self control throughout the month by elementary staff members. The students redeem their Faithful Flyer cards at the Flyer cart, which occurs one to two times a month. There is a cart for grades 1-3 and 4-6 to earn prizes individually and collaboratively as a class. Prizes range in value from 1 Flyer card to 400 Flyer cards!

Literacy Night – Fall 2025

This is an evening for all Early Childhood and Elementary students and their families. The night is filled with books, crafts, and games. Activities will be set up in the Elementary classrooms and Convo Foyer/Cafeteria and there will be prizes to win!

Breakfast of Champions – May 22, 2026

Students in grades 4-6 who receive no more than one disciplinary or homework violation are rewarded for their efforts with a celebratory breakfast. Data is tracked throughout the school year. The principal determines who earns this reward, based upon this information.
