

Purpose of Uniform policy:

Flyers are people who are respectful and respectable. A student should dress in a manner which respects learning and their own human dignity and humility. The SPH Uniform policy is designed to allow reasonable self expression, while reflecting and cultivating a sense of community within our student body. Simplified terms and expectations allow for a clear understanding of the Uniform policy as well as provide a framework for the common sense enforcement of the policies. As Flyers, it is the expectation that students make reasonable choices about how they dress with respect, professionalism and modesty in mind. Administration reserves the right to make final decisions regarding dress code compliance. Families are encouraged to contact the school office with questions or for clarification before purchasing uniforms. The Principal's or Dean of Students' decisions in all matters of dress are considered school policy, equal to the following written guidelines:

Shirt	● Collared dress shirt or polo ● Shirts are to be of solid color: white, red, or black free of patterns or designs. Skirts	● Skirts/Skorts must be a solid color (black) or school approved tartan/plaid and reach the knee or lower in length	● Not Permitted
Shoes	● Shoes must be solid color (brown, black, red, gray or white) and have backs ● Athletic shoes only in school colors (white, red, black, gray) are permitted ● Athletic shoes must have laces and be tied ● Sandals, slippers, flip-flops, canvas van style slip-on shoes, over the knee boots, and backless shoes may not be worn	● Shoes must be solid color (brown, black, red, gray or white) and have backs ● Athletic shoes only in school colors (white, red, black, gray) are permitted ● Athletic shoes must have laces and be tied ● Sandals, slippers, flip-flops, canvas van style slip-on shoes, over the knee boots, and backless shoes may not be worn
Hair Styles	● Hair must be kept clean and well-groomed ● No unnatural colors, two-toned hair color, or exaggerated styles (i.e. mohawks) are allowed ● No excessive lines/carvings are allowed ● Modest natural coloring or highlighting is allowed ● The hair should not be worn in a manner that covers the eyes ● The hair code may be modified at the discretion of the dean, and students are expected to make reasonable choices about their hairstyle ● Any questions should be directed to the dean before any major decisions are made	● Hair must be kept clean and well-groomed ● No unnatural colors, two-toned hair color, or exaggerated styles (i.e. mohawks) are allowed ● No excessive lines/carvings are allowed ● Modest natural coloring or highlighting is allowed ● The hair should not be worn in a manner that covers the eyes ● The hair code may be modified at the discretion of the dean, and students are expected to make reasonable choices about their hairstyle ● It is the expectation that young men are clean shaven ● Any questions should be directed to the dean before any major decisions are made

Outerwear	- Students may wear a singular color (black, red, white) ¼ zip pullover. Small NCS or SPH logos are acceptable - Students may wear a singular color (black, red, white) sweater (crew, cardigan or vest). Small NCS or SPH logos are acceptable. - Coats, hoodies, jackets etc. must be placed in lockers from ‘bell to bell’ and are not permitted to be worn during the school day - Outerwear includes, but is not limited to, coats/jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts, flannel jackets, windbreakers, wind pants, gloves, hats, bandanas, and scarves - Sweatshirts of any type are not permitted without school approval	- Students may wear a singular color (black, red, white) ¼ zip pullover. Jewelry	- No excessive jewelry or body piercing, other than young ladies’ earlobes, are permitted in school or when representing the school at extra-curricular activities - All jewelry must be professional and modest in choice	- No earrings, excessive jewelry or body piercing are permitted in school or when representing the school at extra-curricular activities - All jewelry must be professional and modest in choice
Earrings	- Professional and modest earrings are acceptable - Plugs or gauges are not permitted	Not Permitted
Make-up	Make-up must be professional/modest and chosen from a neutral or natural pallet	- Make-up is not permitted - Nail polish is not permitted

GAME DAY ATTIRE

To further cultivate community among our students and proudly display our school spirit in public, each student in grades 7-12 will receive a St. Paul pullover for the school year. This pullover is to be worn on Mass days, field trips, and other special events during the school year. Students will be expected to wear Game Day attire when instructed and it will be enforced the same as our uniform policies.

ATHLETIC TEAM GEAR

Team-issued athletic apparel may be worn as part of the school uniform provided it aligns with the core expectations of the policy, including being a single, solid school color (black, red, or white) and featuring only a small, singular school logo. The Athletic Department will continue to collaborate with coaches to ensure all team apparel meets these standards. Team-issued sweatshirts and related items may also be worn on designated dress-down and spirit days, which will be offered regularly throughout the school year.
