Purpose of Uniform-Dress Code:

As Faithful Flyers we strive each day to show respect for self and others. A student should dress in a manner which respects learning and their own human dignity and humility. The elementary principal's decisions in all matters of dress are considered school policy, equal to the following written guidelines:

Shirt	• Solid color, collared, button down dress shirt, polo shirt, or full turtlenecks in red, white, or black • These should not have artwork, slogans, pictures or advertising • Shirts/blouses must be long enough to be tucked in and stay tucked in at all times, including lunch time. Shirts should not be low cut or sheer (see through). • Shirts must be buttoned to the 2nd highest button or other reasonable spot • Small pocket logos are acceptable of the school logos. • Undershirts must be solid color red, white, black, or grey with no visible writing/design	• Solid color, collared, button down dress shirt, polo shirt, or full turtlenecks in red, white, or black • These should not have artwork, slogans, pictures or advertising • Shirts/blouses must be long enough to be tucked in and stay tucked in at all times, including lunch time. Shirts should not be low cut or sheer (see through). • Shirts must be buttoned to the 2nd highest button or other reasonable spot • Small pocket logos are acceptable of the school logos. • Undershirts must be solid color red, white, black, or grey with no visible writing/design
Sweaters/ Outerwear	• Students may wear solid colored (red, white, black or grey) sweaters, cardigans or vests • Solid color crewneck sweatshirts with no hood (red, white, black or grey) with no logos other than the school logo • Outerwear includes, but is not limited to, coats/jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts, windbreakers, wind pants, gloves, hats, and scarves. These items should only be worn at the teacher's discretion • We recommend placing a school-appropriate sweater or crew neck in your student's	• Students may wear solid colored (red, white, black or grey) sweaters, cardigans or vests • Solid color crewneck sweatshirts with no hood (red, white, black or grey) with no logos other than the school logo • Outerwear includes, but is not limited to, coats/jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts, windbreakers, wind pants, gloves, hats, and scarves. These items should only be worn at the teacher's discretion • We recommend placing a school-appropriate sweater or crew neck in your student's

Pants	● Solid color dress pants with front pockets in khaki or black. No jeggings, knit pants, or black denim ● Slacks or pants should be of a full-length dress style. Shorts (months of August-October, April-June) *Please consider the weather when selecting shorts. No jeggings, knit pants, or black denim ● Should be of appropriate length; no more than 4 inches above the knee and no longer than to the knee ● Shorts should not be faded or stonewashed ● Shorts should be neatly hemmed with no holes or tears ● Clothing should not be too tight or form fitting ● Capris not permitted	● Solid color dress shorts with front pockets in khaki or black. No jeggings, knit pants, or black denim ● Should be of appropriate length; no more than 4 inches above the knee and no longer than to the knee ● Shorts should not be faded or stonewashed ● Shorts should be neatly hemmed with no holes or tears ● Clothing should not be too tight or form fitting ● Capris not permitted
Skirts/Dresses/Skorts/Jumpers	● These items must reach the knee ● If these items have a slit, it should measure no more than 6" ● These items should not be form fitting ● Plaid items must only be comprised of the colors red, black, and white ● Skirts/skorts must be one solid color; khaki or black only ● Patterns are not permitted (i.e. houndstooth, checkered or polkadot) ● These items may not have holes, or tears and should be neatly hemmed ● Polo style dresses are permitted	● Not Permitted

Leggings/Tights	- These items must be worn under skirts/dresses/skorts - These items must be a solid color red, white, or black with no embellishments or pattern - Patterns are not permitted (i.e. houndstooth, plaid, checkered or polkadot)	Not Permitted
Belts	- Belts must be worn when wearing pants with belt loops, grades 4-6 - Belts must be a solid color (brown or black) with no embellishments (studs, jewels, etc.)	- Belts must be worn when wearing pants with belt loops, grades 4-6 - Belts must be a solid color (brown or black) with no embellishments (studs, jewels, etc.)
Shoes	- Shoes must be primarily a solid color (red, white, black, grey, or brown) and have backs, with no designs or print - Athletic shoes are permitted and preferred within the same guidelines listed above. No high top tennis shoes - Dress shoes are permitted within the same guidelines listed above - Boots (Ugg, work, cowboy, booties, or knee high) sandals, slippers, flip-flops, and backless shoes are not permitted - Shoes with a heel should be low and not above 1 inch - Winter boots may be worn to school, but must be changed into school appropriate shoes upon arrival - Light up shoes are not permitted	- Shoes must be primarily a solid color (red, white, black, grey, or brown) and have backs, with no designs or print - Athletic shoes are permitted and preferred within the same guidelines listed above.
