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Student Enrichment Events

Flyer Cart – All Year

Flyer Cart was created to help recognize positive behavior for students in grades 1-6. Students earn Faithful Flyer cards when demonstrating joy, kindness, or self control throughout the month by elementary staff members. The students redeem their Faithful Flyer cards at the Flyer cart, which occurs one time a month. Students can earn prizes individually or collaboratively as a class. Prizes range in value from 1 Flyer card to 400 Flyer cards.

Literacy Night – September 30, 2026

This is an evening for all Early Childhood and Elementary students and their families. The night is filled with books, crafts, and games. Activities will be set up in the Elementary classrooms, Convo Foyer, Cafeteria, & Court yard.

Breakfast of Champions – May 28, 2027

Students in grades 4-6 who receive no more than one disciplinary or homework violation are rewarded for their efforts with a celebratory breakfast. Data is tracked throughout the school year. The principal determines who earns this reward, based upon this information.
